



環境及自然保育基金自1994年成立以來,一直透過資助 香港合資格機構及社區團體舉辦與環保和自然保育有關 的活動,藉此鼓勵市民在日常行為和生活方式上作出改 變,養成環境保護及低碳生活習慣。

Since its establishment in 1994, the ECF has all along been providing financial support for eligible organisations and community groups in Hong Kong to organise activities in relation to environmental protection and nature conservation. Through these activities, members of the public are encouraged to change their daily behaviour and way of life, and develop a green and low carbon lifestyle.

- ► 為了能**向更多地區團體和社區組織推廣**環境及自然保育基金的資助計劃及 範圍,秘書處邀請了各民政事務處提名轄下地區內有興趣申請項目資助的 非牟利機構及代表,出席第一場簡介會。

- In order to **promote** the ECF funding schemes and its scope **to more district bodies and community groups**, the Secretariat has invited District Offices to nominate non-profit-making organisations (and their representatives) under their districts who are interested to apply for project grants under the ECF to attend the First Briefing Session.
- District Officers and/or their representatives are also invited to attend the Briefing Session with a view to expressing their encouragement and support to the district bodies under their purview.

維護國家安全

Safeguarding National Security

- ▶ 申請機構遞交申請表格時,必須填妥並同時遞交確認書(申請表格的A部),以代表其**明白及同意下述條款**:
 - 政府保留權利以機構曾經參與、正在參與或有理由相信機構曾 經或正在參與可能導致或構成發生危害國家安全罪行的行為或 活動為由,取消其申請資格,
 - 又或為維護國家安全,或為保障香港的公眾利益、公共道德、 公共秩序或公共安全,而有必要剔除機構日後申請的資格。
- Applicant organisation has to submit an Agreement (Session A of the Application Form) along with the application form, to confirm that your organisation has understood and agreed with the following clauses:-
 - the Government reserves the right to disqualify the organisation on the grounds that it has engaged, is engaging, or is reasonably believed to have engaged or be engaging in acts or activities that are likely to cause or constitute the occurrence of offences endangering national security;
 - or otherwise the exclusion of the organisation from future applications is necessary in the interest of national security, or is necessary to protect the public interest of Hong Kong, public morals, public order or public safety.

Safeguarding National Security

- ▶ 即使有關申請已獲批准,如果出現下列任何一種情況,政府可立即 撤回或取消有關批准:
 - ○機構曾經參與或正在參與可能會構成或導致發生危害國家安全罪 行或不利於國家安全的行為或活動;
 - ○繼續委約該機構或繼續推行該環境及自然保育基金項目將不利於 國家安全;或
 - 政府合理地相信上述任何一種情況將會發生。
- Even after the application is approved, the Government may immediately withdraw or cancel the relevant approval upon the occurrence of any of the following events:
 - the organisation has engaged or is engaging in acts or activities that are likely to constitute or cause the occurrence of offences endangering national security or which would otherwise be contrary to the interest of national security;
 - the continued engagement of the organisation or the continued implementation of the ECF project is contrary to the interest of national security; or
 - the Government reasonably believes that any of the events mentioned above is about to occur.

- The **Head or Deputy Head** of the applicant organisation should complete the agreement relating to safeguarding national security in **Section A** of the application form for each application. An application will be considered **invalid** if this section is not duly completed and submitted along with the application form.

The project **helped enhance** the target groups' awareness and practice of and participation in environmental protection/conservation.



申請機構的**能力及過往表現良好**。 **Capability and track record** of the applicant organisation were **good**.



計劃書內容不完整,未有就如何有效推廣環保教育作出足夠闡述。

The project proposal was incomplete and lacked adequate elaboration on how to effectively promote environmental education.



環保教育元素薄弱,項目活動與環保教育的目標不相符。

The environmental education elements were weak and the project activities did not align with the objectives of environmental education.



各活動之間連繫薄弱,令項目整體內容渙散及不協調。

The connection among activities was weak, resulting in a lack of overall focus and coherence of the project.



申請機構**未能展示其具有專業環保知識**,及未有落實具專業環保知識的協辦/贊助/協助機構,項目能傳遞全面和正確環保訊息能力存疑。

The applicant organisation failed to demonstrate that it possessed professional environmental knowledge, and no professional body with environmental knowledge had confirmed to serve as Coorganising/sponsoring/supporting organisations. The project's ability to convey comprehensive and accurate environmental messages was doubtful.



所涉及**預算偏高**。大部分項目開支用於聘請員工;購買資本物品;或行政及一般支出等。

The applied budget was on the high side. Majority of the project expenditures were allocated to staffing; procurement of capital items; or administrative and general expenses, etc.

項目涉及商業元素。

Commercial element was involved in the project.



項目預計參加人數偏低,成本效益存疑。

The expected number of participants of the project was limited. The cost-effectiveness was doubtful.



重複申請機構 / 其他團體 / 政府部門曾經或正在舉辦的類似活動及對象。

Similar activities were or are being organised by the applicant organisation / other organisations / government departments for the same target groups.



項目的活動內容及對象,**與申請機構以往的申請相似**,並無明顯增益之處。

The project was similar to the organisation's previous applications in terms of activity content and target participants without significant enhancement.



就申請機構以往獲資助的項目,其遞交報告的進度/完成關鍵成效指標的能力未如理想,機構在**行政和項目管理/執行方面的能力成疑。**

Regarding the previous approved projects of the applicant organisation, its report submission progress/ability to complete key performance indicators were not satisfactory. The applicant organisation 's administrative and project management/implementation abilities were doubtful.



項目側重於設備安裝。

The project placed too much emphasis on the installation of facilities.



目標參加者對項目主題已有相當的了解。

The target participants already had considerable understanding on the project theme.



如同時接獲多份相同/相類似的申請書,有關申請會被一併考慮,一般不會獲優先考慮。

For several identical/highly similar applications received, these applications will be considered in one go and will normally not be accorded higher priority.



申請機構**沒有詳細說明**,如何能有效推廣環保教育活動及 達成項目目標。

The applicant organisation did not provide details on how to effectively promote the environmental education activities and achieve project objectives.



申請機構**未有提供足夠資料,以評估**項目活動就推廣環保 教育的**成效**。

No adequate information was provided by the applicant organisation to assess the effectiveness of the project activities in promoting environmental education.



項目的方向與政府現行政策不符。

The direction of the project was not in line with the prevailing government policy.

須**避免**事宜 Matters to be **Avoided**

 No consideration on the sustainable development of the project.

- 以「零碳排放·綠色宜居·持續發展」為願景,提出香港應對氣候變化和 2050年前實現碳中和的策略和目標。
















Hong Kong's Climate Action Plan 香港氣候行動藍圖






