維護國家安全

Safeguarding National Security

- ▶ 申請機構遞交申請表格時，必須填妥並同時遞交確認書（申請表格的A部），以代表其**明白及同意下述條款**：
 - 政府保留權利以機構曾經參與、正在參與或有理由相信機構曾經或正在參與可能導致或構成發生危害國家安全罪行的行為或活動為由，**取消其申請資格**；
 - 又或為維護國家安全，或為保障香港的公眾利益、公共道德、公共秩序或公共安全，而有必要**剔除機構日後申請的資格**。
- ▶ Applicant organisation has to submit an Agreement (Session A of the Application Form) along with the application form, to confirm that your organisation has understood and agreed with the following clauses:-
 - the Government reserves the right to disqualify the recipient organisation on the grounds that it has engaged, is engaging, or is reasonably believed to have engaged or be engaging in acts or activities that are likely to cause or constitute the occurrence of offences endangering national security;
 - or otherwise the exclusion of the organisation from future applications is necessary in the interest of national security, or is necessary to protect the public interest of Hong Kong, public morals, public order or public safety.

Safeguarding National Security

- ▶ 即使有關申請已獲批准，如果出現下列任何一種情況，政府可**立即撤回或取消有關批准**：
 - 機構曾經參與或正在參與可能會構成或導致發生危害國家安全罪行或不利於國家安全的行為或活動；
 - 繼續委約機構或繼續推行該環境及自然保育基金項目將不利於國家安全；或
 - 政府合理地相信上述任何一種情況將會發生。
- ▶ Even after the application is approved, the Government may immediately withdraw or cancel the relevant approval upon the occurrence of any of the following events:
 - the organisation has engaged or is engaging in acts or activities that are likely to constitute or cause the occurrence of offences endangering national security or which would otherwise be contrary to the interest of national security;
 - the continued engagement of the organisation or the continued implementation of the ECF project is contrary to the interest of national security; or
 - the Government reasonably believes that any of the events mentioned above is about to occur.

An application will be considered invalid if this section is not duly completed and submitted along with the application form.

The cost for delivering food waste to Government treatment facilities should be included in the budget of the project. If the project is approved, the Applicant shall coordinate with the EPD regarding **the food waste delivery arrangement**. If the EPD can provide free food waste collection service, the budget allocated for the associated cost shall not be used.

- 環保署在**2018年**推出先導計劃，並在**2023年初**擴展服務至全港
- 為廚餘量較多的處所，**例如食物工場、商場、酒店、街市、醫院、大學、屋苑等**，提供**免費點對點**的廚餘收集服務
- 現時約**1 600**個收集點，廚餘回收量不斷上升，2025年平均每日收集量約**350公噸**廚餘。
- 運送至中央處理設施，再**轉化為電力和堆肥**
- The Pilot Scheme launched in 2018 and further expanded to cover the whole territory in early 2023
- Providing free door-to-door collection service to premises with larger quantity of food waste, **e.g. public markets, hospitals, shopping malls, hotels, food factories, institutions, residential estates**
- **About 1 600 no.** of food waste collection points now, an increasing trend with daily food waste collection quantity **~350 tpd** in 2025
- Central food waste treatment, **converting into electricity and compost**

Domestic Food Waste Collection

公共屋邨廚餘收集計劃 (PRH)

- 截至2026年3月，環保署已在全港**221個公共屋邨**（近1 500座樓宇）安裝約**1060個**智能廚餘回收桶，當中141個公共屋邨已實現「一座一桶」的目標。

As at October 2025, the EPD has installed a total of about **1060** Food Waste Smart Recycling Bins (FWSRBs) **in 221 PRH estates** (about 1 500 blocks), and among them 141 estates have achieved the “one FWSRB per block” target.

私人屋苑廚餘收集 (Private Housing Estates)

- 透過環境運動委員會的「**私人屋苑智能廚餘回收桶試驗計劃**」資助私人屋苑安裝智能廚餘回收桶計劃。計劃的戶數申請門檻，已由1 000戶或以上降至200戶或以上。
- Subsidising private housing estates to install FWSRBs through “**Pilot Scheme on Food Waste Smart Recycling Bins in Private Housing Estates**” under Environmental Campaign Committee. Application threshold has been lowered from 1,000 households or more to 200 households or more.

Public Food Waste Collection Points

環保署社區回收網絡 EPD's Community Recycling Network

已在五個較鄰近住宅區的回收環保站「綠在深水埗」、「綠在東區」、「綠在西貢」、「綠在沙田」及「綠在屯門」設置智能廚餘回收桶，收集鄰近的家居廚餘（包括單幢式大廈和「三無大廈」）

FWSRBs installed at **GREEN@SHAM SHUI PO**, **GREEN@EASTERN**, **GREEN@SAI KUNG**, **GREEN@SHA TIN** and **GREEN@TUEN MUN** located **near single-block / 3-nil buildings** to collect food waste from general public



廚餘回收流動點 Food Waste Recycling Spots

在鄰近單幢式大廈、村屋和食肆較集中的地點設立「廚餘回收流動點」，以**定時定點**的方式**在夜間**收集附近家居和食肆產生的廚餘。現時已設立了**105**個「廚餘回收流動點」包括**103**個路邊回收站及一輛流動回收車（停靠**2**個地點）。

Set up Food Waste Recycling Spots near single-block/ 3-nil buildings, villages and eateries that **operate at fixed hours and locations every evening** to collect food waste from both residents and eateries. There are currently 105 Recycling Spots, including 103 kerbside booths and one mobile recycling truck (stopping at 2 locations)

Set up Food Waste Recycling Points **at 110 public refuse collection points** (RCP) under the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (FEHD) to collect food waste generated by restaurants and households nearby.

Set up public collection point **at 36 FEHD' s public markets** with FWSRBs for collecting food waste from general public, and will be expanded to more public markets gradually.

Future Development of Smart Recycling

Carry out smart recycling projects on application and/or development of artificial intelligence, big data technologies, etc.
- ▶ 進行有助提高社區參與乾淨回收的項目，如利用人工智能辨識可回收物及建議合適的回收點，利用大數據預測及評估社區回收支援措施
Carry out projects that can enhance community participation in clean recycling, recognising recyclables, and advise on suitable outlets by utilising artificial intelligence, predicting and evaluating the effectiveness of community recycling support measures by application of big data analytics, etc.

Reduction of disposable plastics

Apply innovative technologies / effective methods in projects to facilitate reducing the use of disposable tableware at source, including:

- ✓ Encouraging members of the public to adopt "Bring-Your-Own-Containers (BYOC) " when ordering takeaways
- ✓ Reusable tableware lending / central tableware washing
- ✓ Encouraging catering businesses to test and gradually expand the use of non-plastic containers
- ✓ Facilitating resource recovery and pre-treatment of used disposable tableware (e.g. plant-fibre based tableware).



管制即棄膠餐具和其他塑膠產品

Regulation of Disposable Plastic Tableware and Other Plastic Products

為從源頭減少使用即棄塑膠產品，第一階段管制即棄膠餐具和其他塑膠產品已於**2024年4月22日開始實施**。

To reduce the use of disposable plastic products at source, the first phase of Regulation of Disposable Plastic Tableware and Other Plastic Products came into effect on 22 April 2024.

當中，**第一階段管制**包括：

- 禁止**銷售**及禁止餐飲處所向**外賣**顧客提供**發泡膠餐具、飲管、攪拌棒、叉刀匙和碟**；
- 禁止餐飲處所向**堂食**顧客提供**任何即棄膠餐具(包括杯、杯蓋、食物容器及食物容器蓋)**。

The first phase regulation consists of:

- Prohibits the sale and provision of EPS tableware, straws, stirrers, forks, knives, spoons and plates at catering premises to customers takeaway services;
- Prohibits the provision of any disposable plastic tableware (Including cups, cup lids, food containers and food container covers) to dine-in customers at catering premises.



管制即棄膠餐具和其他塑膠產品

Regulation of Disposable Plastic Tableware and Other Plastic Products

第二階段管制計劃涵蓋的即棄塑膠餐具主要是**外賣常用的塑膠杯和塑膠食物容器**。

The second phase regulation major consists of tableware commonly used in takeaway meal, i.e. disposable plastic cups and food containers.

為與餐飲業界共同探索在業務中進一步走塑，環境保護署（環保署）於2025年8月中推出「非塑膠容器試驗計劃」，公開招募業界試用各類非塑膠容器，並就產品的功能表現提供意見。

In order to collaborate with the catering businesses to further explore going plastic-free in their operations, the Environmental Protection Department (EPD) launched the Non-Plastic Container Trial Programme in mid-August 2025, openly inviting the trade to participate in the trial use of various types of non-plastic containers and provide feedback on product performance.

在實施進一步強制使用替代品前，政府會充分考慮相關非塑膠替代品的成熟度、普及性和可負擔性，以保護環境、符合業界需要，和市民接受為目標，務實推進減少使用塑膠。

Before implementation of further mandating the use of alternatives, the Government will thoroughly consider the maturity, availability and affordability of the relevant non-plastic alternatives with the goal of aligning environmental protection with industry needs and public acceptance, thereby pragmatically advancing plastic reduction.

Waste Reduction at Source

- ▶ 推動源頭走塑、減少使用即棄塑膠及鼓勵使用可重用的代替品

To promote the elimination of plastics at source, reduction of disposable plastics and encourage the use of reusable alternatives.



- ▶ 推廣惜食文化，鼓勵食肆與顧客共同從源頭減少廚餘。

To promote the culture of cherishing food, and encourage eateries to reduce food waste at source together with customers.



塑膠購物袋收費計劃

Plastic Shopping Bag (PSB) Charging Scheme

2015年4月1日起於零售業界全面推行。

2022年12月31日起優化措施：每個膠袋收費提高至最低一元；

取消盛載冰凍或冷凍食品的膠袋的豁免；收緊盛載沒有包裝及非氣密食品的膠袋的豁免。

Fully implemented in the entire retail sector since 1 April 2015. Enhanced since 31 December 2022: increasing the charging level per PSB to at least \$1; removing the exemption for PSBs carrying frozen/chilled foodstuff items; and tightening the exemption for PSBs carrying foodstuff items without packaging or in non-airtight packaging.



玻璃飲料容器生產者責任計劃

Producer Responsibility Scheme on Glass Beverage Containers

Producer Responsibility Scheme on Plastic Beverage Containers and Beverage Cartons

正進行相關法律條文的草擬工作，並會繼續就完善計劃的運作細節與相關持份者和業界作密切溝通，要求各相關持份者共同承擔環保責任，妥善收集和處理塑膠飲料容器及紙包飲品盒，以轉化成有市場價值的回收物料。此外，計劃建議提供回贈，以鼓勵公眾交回用完的塑膠飲料容器及紙包飲品盒。

In the progress of drafting the relevant legislative proposals and will continue to communicate closely with stakeholders and trades to finalise the operational details of the PRS, which would require stakeholders to share the environmental responsibilities of collecting and treating plastic beverage containers and beverage cartons, thereby turning them into marketable recycled materials. Furthermore, the Scheme proposed to include rebates to encourage people to return used plastic beverage containers and beverage cartons.

3 分類回收

Waste Separation and Recycling

環保署致力發展回收網絡，自2015年起開展的「綠在區區」，服務範圍已擴展至全港18區，並統一接收**九類回收物**（即廢紙、金屬、塑膠（包括發泡膠）、玻璃容器、慳電膽／光管、充電電池、小型電器、四電一腦及紙包飲品盒）。除上述九類回收物以外，環保署亦積極推動廚餘回收。

The EPD is sparing no effort in developing the community recycling network. The Green@Community, which started in 2015, serves members of the public territory-wide, and collect nine types of recyclables (namely paper, metals, different types of plastics (including styrofoam), glass containers, fluorescent lamps and tubes, rechargeable batteries, small electrical appliances, regulated waste electrical and electronic equipment and beverage cartons). Besides the nine types of recyclables mentioned above, the EPD is also actively promoting food waste recycling.
